

Project Title: *Examining the Nature & Context of Intimate Partner Violence in 2SLGBTQ+ Communities*

In partnership with Sageesse Domestic Violence Prevention Society, researchers at the University of Calgary are conducting a study to examine the nature and context of intimate partner violence within 2SLGBTQ+ communities. We are interested in talking to victims/survivors about their experiences seeking help and the barriers that existed in relation to accessing these services.

Criteria for participation includes the following:

- Over the age of 18 years
- Experienced violence in a domestic relationship within the last 10 years (2010-2020)
- Identification with the 2SLGBTQ+ community
- Currently in a safe situation free from violence

The interviews will take 1 - 2 hours and will be conducted over the telephone.

Your participation in an interview and any information that could identify you personally will be kept confidential. An \$40 honorarium is available for interview participants. This research has been approved by the University of Calgary Conjoint Health Research Ethics Board (REB20-1461).
