

To CREATING a Micro-credential

Have an idea for a microcredential?

Here is the <u>process</u> for creating a micro-credential

Consultation

Arrange a **consultation** meeting with the assistant dean faculty development to establish a partnership approach to oversight of the micro-credential.

This promotes quality assurance and considers sustainability associated with the offering of the micro-credential over time.



Description

Provide a **description** of the micro-credential. Include why the micro-credential is important and the learning need that it will fulfill for participants.



Learning Goals

List the **learning goals** associated with the microcredential. These should be reflected as action oriented.



Criteria

List the **criteria** that participants will need to fulfill to successfully complete the microcredential and receive a digital badge.




Resources

List the evidence informed resources that support participants' learning.



Lesson Plan

Complete a **lesson plan** outlining the description and learning goals in addition to the **learner activities** that support participants to complete the micro-credential criteria.





Final Consultation

Arrange a **final consultation** meeting with the assistant dean faculty development to finalize getting the micro-credential onto the faculty website and D2L.
