## Be prepared to justify ALL of your costs

Fees for a conference presentation \$1800.

#### VS.

Fees for attending 3-day conference to present findings at the 2021 Canadian Rheumatology Association. Return Airfare Calgary to Toronto = \$800; Accommodation at Best Western Toronto 3 days/4 nights\*\$150/night (includes taxes) = \$600; Registration fees for one team member = \$300; UCalgary per diem rate for national travel \$51/day\*3 days = \$153. **Total = \$1853.** 



- Write down a draft list of items as you are developing your methods and knowledge translation sections.
- If there are items you aren't sure of in terms of price, start trying to figure out quotes to save time later.



 If there is an application system, log in and check the requirements for uploading and formatting the budget to avoid last minute surprises when applying.

#### Personnel

#### Personnel

- This is usually the largest budget category in terms of funds asked
- The people typically doing the day-to-day work and may not include specialized/professional services/consultants (in another category)
- Generally funding applications will say that you determine pay rate/benefits as laid out by the institution (i.e., UCalgary's rules/guidelines for hiring)



#### Research Staff/Non-Students

- Paid as employees/AUPE
  - Salary depends on AUPE classification
  - You need to account for benefits in your personnel costs. See this webpage to download a benefits cost calculator to get the best estimate of this for your budget: <u>https://www.ucalgary.ca/finance/</u>



### Personnel

- Trainees/Students
  - Undergrad
    - Usually hired casual, hourly basis, Phase 1 AUPE
    - Salary \$17-20/hour + 10.4% for benefits
    - Maximum 22.5 hours/week
  - Graduate
    - As GAR (Graduate Assistant Research)
       O Hourly basis, GSA
      - Salary \$25-40/hour + 8% for benefits
      - Maximum 450 hours per GAR year (July-June)
    - With Stipend



Don't forget salary increments for AUPE!

 Typically, the rate is 3% per year – just add to the hourly rate from the previous year (example coming up)



## **Travel Costs**

#### Travel Costs

- Be realistic and reasonable
- Travel related to doing the research
- Travel related to dissemination/KT
  - if this is too high it may look unreasonable



#### Travel Costs – for Research

- Travel to sites for training RAs
- Gas/mileage for recruitment
- Vehicle rentals
- Accommodation for data collection trips
  - List of preferred hotel vendors



## **Travel Costs**

- Travel Costs for Dissemination/KT
  - Conference registration fees
  - Airfare
  - Accommodation
  - Per diem for food/sustenance
    - o Canada \$51 CAD/day
    - United States \$51 USD/day
    - International \$75 CAD/day
  - Travel to and from airport (taxi, bus, etc.)



## Materials and Supplies

## Materials and Supplies/Consumables

- Office supplies (pens, chart paper, etc.)
- Hospitality
  - Food/drinks for focus groups
- Recruitment posters and printing



## Equipment/Non-consumables

- Computer
- Audio recorder
- USB keys
- Photography equipment



## **Prof Services/Consultants**

- Professional Services/Consultants
  - Biostatistician
    - usually \$80/hour
  - Transcription
    - usually \$25-\$35/hour 3 hours of transcription for 1 hour of audio
    - \$1.50/minute for online service
- Other examples:
  - Program evaluation consultant
  - Computer programmer
  - Photographer
  - Web developer



- Dissemination/Knowledge Translation
  - Open access fees for journals
    - Example: BMC Nursing
    - https://bmcnurs.biomedcentral.com/
  - Symposium/meetings with community
  - Catering for events
  - Intervention handbooks
  - Posters/flyers



## Other Expenses

- Advertising costs for recruitment
  - (e.g., social media)
- Honorarium
- Incentives
- Professional development for training
